Review of Reopening Task Force Report - Nick Johnson

Reviewed Report and COVID Act Now website. Nick had a discussion with the facilities folks and the airflow is recycling three times an hour at a minimum. Facilities is also upgrading filters.

- Vera presented additional information from Dr. Kurra's call last week. We are at a dangerous community spread level.
- Jeff clarified the school reopening decision. Simonds email stated most face to face time and content in the event we have to transition to level three in the fall.
- Steve presented additional information from Dr. Kurra not enough testing. And double the numbers when accounting for asymptomatic.
- Kirsten Dr. Kurra was favorable to the precautions we proposed. Maybe not ready for public events but should be able to have small rehearsals in our space.
- Malcom has knowledge of a grant that could help with the cost of masks. Will provide to Nick.

Reopening to Rehearsals

• Kirsten – two groups. One of nine (woodwinds in historic theatre for one hour). One of 11 (strings – in the studio theatre for an hour) Masks required when not playing.

 - D. All participants at this level will be held to our safety standards re: masking and social distancing as set by the executive director and will sign a document reflecting that agreement.
